#### Investing Their Time: JM Family Enterprises, TIL Life Skills Class

One of our long-time partners, **JM Family Enterprises**, continues to support our Transitional Independent Living (TIL 2:25) Residents by regularly hosting Life Skills Classes designed to promote healthy habits and provide essential knowledge these young adults can carry into their futures.

On April 14th, the latest Life Skills Class took place onsite at JM Family's "Nest" (their kitchen/cafeteria), led by Chef John and his team. During this hands-on session, TIL residents learned how to prepare a delicious meal of stuffed chicken with broccoli and cheese, jasmine rice pilaf, and roasted garden vegetables.

In addition to gaining culinary skills, each participant received baking sheets, kitchen utensils, and all the ingredients needed to recreate the meal at home—equipping them with both knowledge and tools for continued success. After the class, everyone gathered to enjoy a shared dinner of chicken alfredo pasta, strawberry field salad, and garlic parmesan rolls.

Lisa Davis, Director of Community Impact at JM Family Enterprises explained, "Giving back is part of our culture at JM Family, and we are honored to partner with 4KIDS. Watching the participants interact, open up, share laughter while preparing a nutritious meal, and ultimately break bread together was truly the highlight of our experience."
